Objectives: The investment objective of this investment fund is to achieve an increase in value by investing in equities of innovative companies, without regional restrictions. Companies that have proven innovative strength qualify for stock selection. The following assessment criteria (not exhaustive) are used when selecting stocks: - Expenditures on research and development - Research collaborations - Patent applications - Innovation process management in the company The sub-fund will continuously invest at least 51% of its assets directly in equities. The proportion of equity-type securities and rights shall amount to 100% of the Fund's assets (after deduction of liquid funds). In this case, less than 10% of the Fund's assets may be invested in securities (including derivatives) of the same issuer. Currency risks from investments in equity-type securities and rights may be hedged against the Fund's reference currency. The sub-fund can therefore not invest more than 10% of its net asset value in UCITS or UCIs including ETFs. The Sub-Fund will not engage in securities lending and/or repurchase agreements (repo and/or reverse repo transactions) and will not invest in total return swaps. The Fund is a product in accordance with Article 8 of the European Disclosure Regulation 2019/2088. The currently implemented investment policy will be reported in the reports. Depending on the market situation, the net assets of the sub-fund may also be invested in all legally permissible assets in accordance with Section 4 of the General Section of the Prospectus.

Intended retail investor: In the member state of origin, the product is intended for professional and private investors with a long-term investment horizon, basic experience and who are able to bear a full financial loss. The product may be used for capital appreciation.

The risk indicator assumes you keep the product until 6 years.

We have classified this product as 4 out of 7, which is a medium risk class. This rates the potential losses from future performance at a medium level, and poor market conditions could impact our capacity to pay you.

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Performance-Scenarios:

What you will get from this product depends on future market performance. Market developments in the future are uncertain and cannot be accurately predicted. 
Recommended holding period: 6 years
