

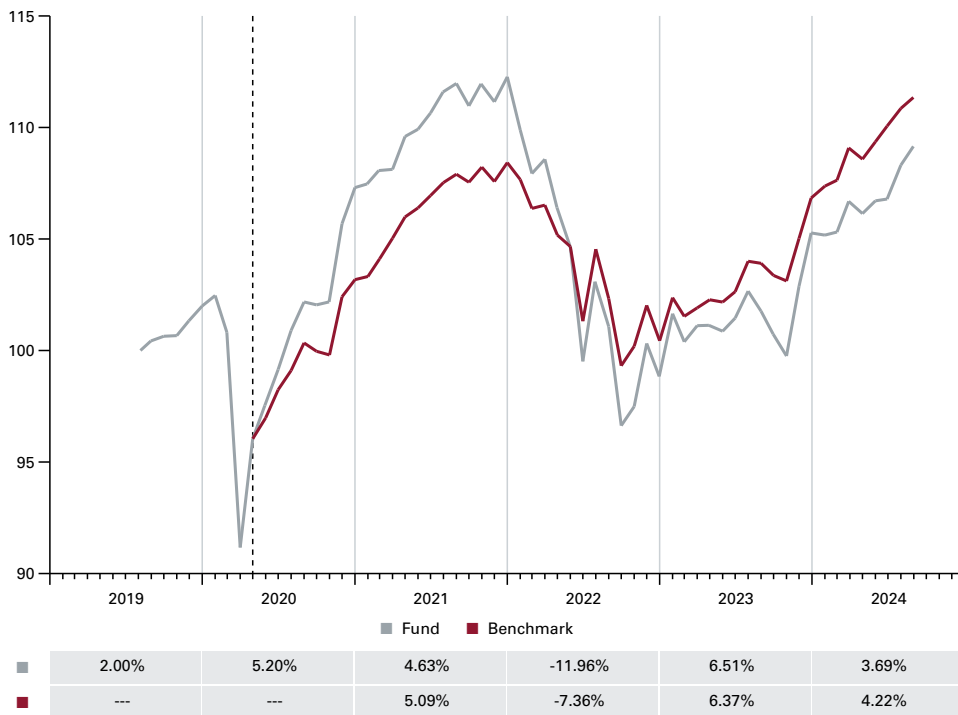

Fund Objective

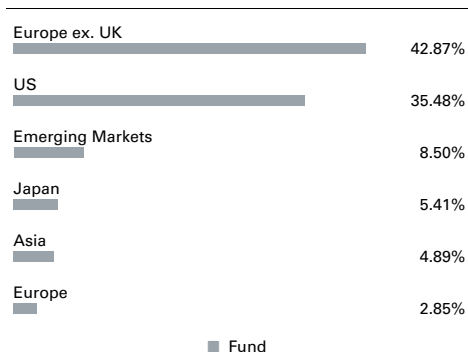

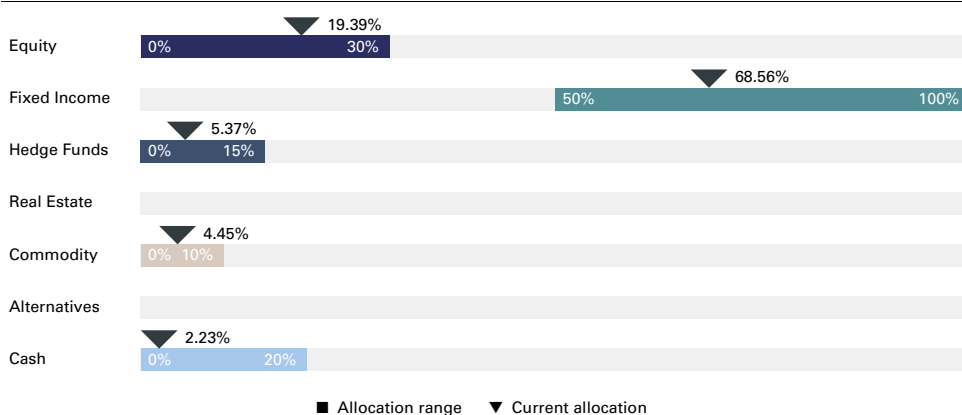
