Fund Profile

The objective of the Fund is to achieve capital appreciation in the long term by investing in a long-only portfolio of equities and equity-related securities. The Fund invests primarily in a combination of actively managed funds, ETFs as well as single stock positions. Equity derivatives could be employed but their use is expected to be rather limited. The geographic exposure of the Fund is global, but with a core focus on European equity markets. The top-down geographic allocation of the Fund reflects the inputs elaborated by the internal Tactical Asset Allocation Committee whilst bottom-up investment decisions are delegated to the Fund Manager.

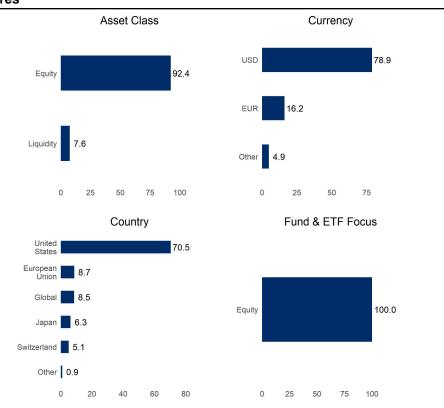

Monthly Commentary

The Centrica Global Equity Fund gained +1.13% (EUR terms) in October. The month was marked by volatility, with equities declining after strong gains earlier in the year. Developed market equities fell 2%, led by small caps (-2.7%), while growth stocks outperformed value, slipping 1.8%. The S&P 500 dropped 0.9%, despite strong U.S. economic data, including robust payroll growth and a 2.8% GDP increase for Q3. Earnings season revealed mixed results, especially for tech, highlighting waning earnings momentum. Japan led performance, with the TOPIX gaining 1.9%, but Europe and China faced challenges. European equities slid 3.2%, driven by German manufacturing weakness. In China, policy measures aimed at stabilizing the real estate sector and spurring growth have yet to yield significant results. The top contributors were SPDR S&P U.S. Communication Services Select Sector UCITS ETF, iShares S&P 500 Information Technology Sector UCITS ETF and SPDR S&P US Financials Select Sector UCITS ETF. Bottom contributors were Amundi MSCI Japan UCITS ETF, iShares S&P 500 Health Care Sector UCITS ETF and Copernicus Swiss Equities Strategy.
