The objective of Piguet Active Prévoyance 40 is to generate regular income and moderate capital gains over time. When selecting investments, the legal provisions relating to occupational old-age, survivor and disability pension (OPP 2) will be taken into account. The sub-fund invests, directly or indirectly, a minimum of 25% of its assets in bonds worldwide and 50% in shares of companies from all over the world. The sub-fund is also authorised to invest in real estate, via units of collective investment schemes and real estate companies, up to a maximum of 15%. Cash is authorised up to a maximum of 25% of the assets. The sub-fund may also invest up to a maximum of 15% in units of other collective investments (alternative, commodities or precious metals) as well as structured products on commodities or precious metals and their indices. 

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
