The fund invests in companies that are headquartered in Switzerland or conduct a predominant part of their business in Switzerland and are included in the SPI 20 index. The sub-fund has little diversification and seeks out the best investment opportunities through a management approach combining qualitative, fundamental, and behavioural analysis.

Class B: open to (i) investors who subscribe and maintain a minimum of CHF 5 million, (ii) investors whose units are subscribed for under a management or advisory mandate according to the terms of the fund contract, and (iii) collective investment schemes.



Risk profile






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Sector breakdown (%)
