
Objective

The Compartment mainly invests in deposits and in short-term, highly rated investment-grade money market instruments that are either denominated in euro (EUR) or systematically hedged to this currency (meaning investments have little or no exposure to currency risk). These are issued by governments or public organisations in developed countries. **Investment Process**

In actively managing the Compartment, the investment manager uses a combination of market and issuer

analysis to identify those securities that offer the best performance in light of interest rate trends. The Compartment's management approach uses strict risk controls. The investment manager considers ESG factors a core element of its strategy by adopting a best in class approach which seeks to invest in securities of issuers with low sustainability risks while avoiding those with high sustainability risks, subject to good governance practices. Activities that adversely affect society or the environment are also avoided. There may be engagement with companies to positively influence ESG practices. For further information, please refer to our exclusion framework in the Responsible Investment policy*, SFDR product category Article 8. The portfolio composition is not constrained relative to the benchmark, so the similarity of the Compartment's performance to that of the benchmark may vary.






Ratings breakdown (% of asset)




Maturity profile (% of asset)




Risk Country (% of asset)

FINANCIAL GLOSSARY

Conversion fee

Fee paid for the transfer of shares of one unit/share class to another unit/share class.

Standard deviation and annualised volatility

Annualised volatility is a risk indicator showing the extent of the price fluctuations of a security or fund unit compared to its average price over a given period. The higher the volatility, the greater the fluctuations.

Inception date

The inception date is the date taken into account for the start of performance calculation. It corresponds to the launch date.

Launch date

The launch date is the date when the sub-fund was activated in its current legal status.

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Order deadline

Deadline for remittance of orders to the transfer agent in Luxembourg as set out in the relevant annexes to the prospectus. You may be required to submit your orders to your financial advisor or fund distributor by an earlier cut-off time.

Rating

The rating is a score awarded by rating agencies reflecting their opinion on the creditworthiness of an issuer.

Weighted average life (WAL)

WAL stands for 'Weighted Average Life'. It is used as an indication of credit risk.

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Weighted average maturity (WAM)

WAM stands for 'Weighted Average Maturity'. It is used as an indication of interest rate risk.

Variable Net Asset Value (VNAV)

Variable Net Asset Value (VNAV) funds are MMFs in which investors purchase or redeem units in the fund at a variable net asset value. VNAV funds may be categorised as either Short Term or Standard MMFs.

Ongoing Costs

The ongoing charges figure is based on expenses for the last 12 months. This figure may vary from year to year. It includes the management fees and other administrative or operating costs. It excludes performance fees and portfolio transaction costs, except in the case of an entry/exit charge paid by the Compartment when buying or selling units/shares in another collective investment undertaking. For funds created less than 12 months ago, future costs are estimated.

SRI

The Summary Risk Indicator (SRI) is defined by the PRIIPs regulation and is designed to show the relative risk of a product, using a combination of market and credit risk measures.

This indicator measures the amount of carbon produced per unit of Gross Domestic Product (GDP), measured in Kton per EURm of gross domestic product (GDP). GHG emissions include both territorial and traded emissions from energy use, land use, land use changes and forestry.

Number of investee countries subject to social violations as referred to in

international treaties and conventions, United Nations principles and, where applicable, national law. Information is based on by third-party data and may not reflect our internal view.

SFDR Classification

Article 9: Investments that target economic activities that are environmentally and/or socially sustainable, provided that the companies in which the investments are made follow good governance practices.
