Fund description

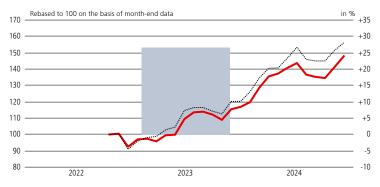
- · Actively managed fund that invests worldwide in companies that have ESG performance characteristics that are expected to improve over time.
