- The exchange rate risk between USD and JPY is not hedged.

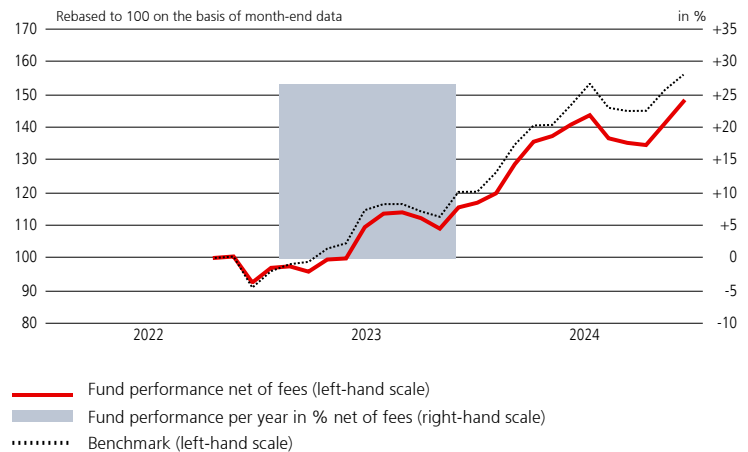
