Due to the sale of call options, the fund can lag behind general growth levels during bull market phases. Despite the dynamic asset allocation adapting to various market cycle stages, the fund may nevertheless fail to meet its target income range. The combination of a medium to high risk profile and regular income payments out of the fund (out of distributing classes), results in a heightened risk of experiencing a diminution in value over time.
