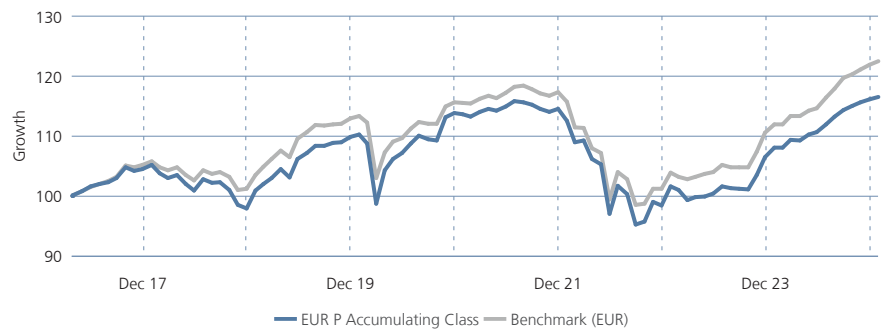

RISK CONSIDERATIONS
