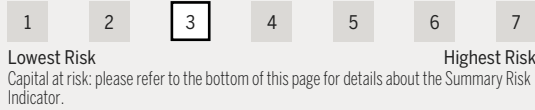

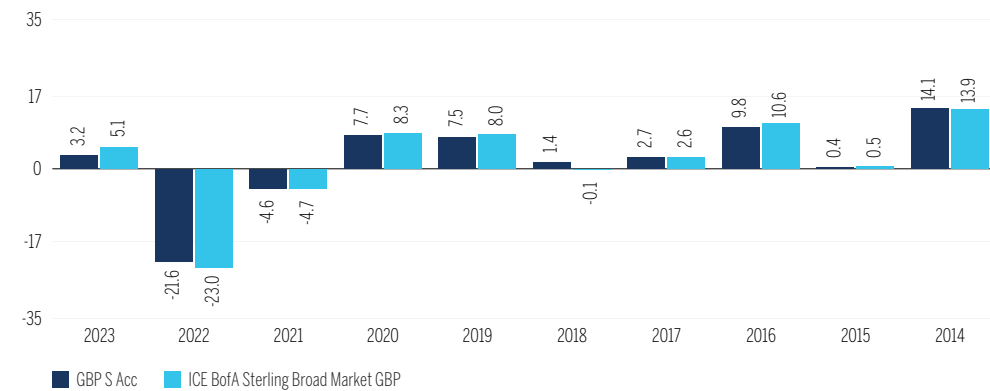

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WHAT ARE THE RISKS?

CAPITAL: Investment markets are subject to economic, regulatory, market sentiment and political risks. All investors should consider the risks that may impact their capital, before investing. LEVERAGE: The use of leverage can provide more market exposure than the money paid or deposited when the transaction is entered into. Losses may therefore exceed the original amount invested.

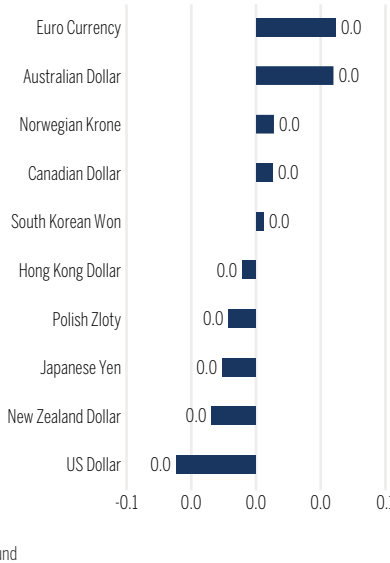

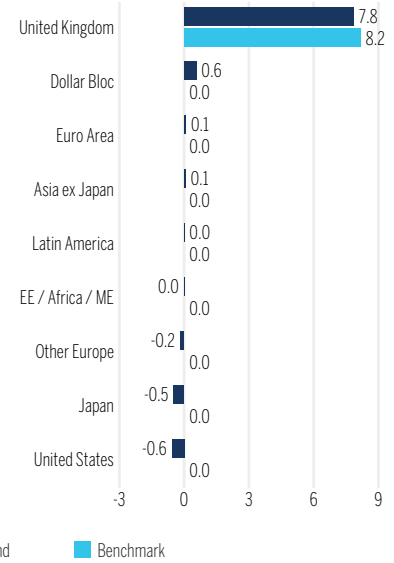
TOP AND BOTTOM 5 ACTIVE CURRENCY EXPOSURE

GEOGRAPHIC DISTRIBUTION

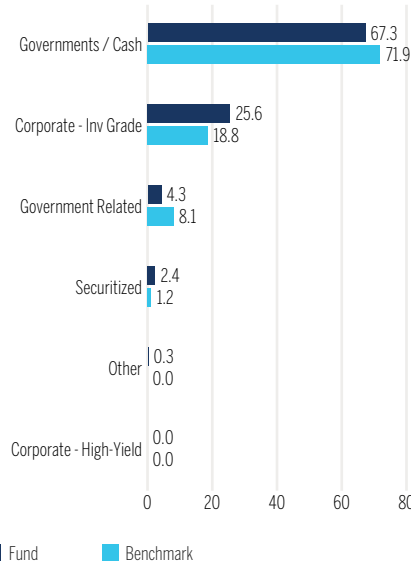
CONTRIBUTION TO DURATION (YRS)

SECTOR DISTRIBUTION

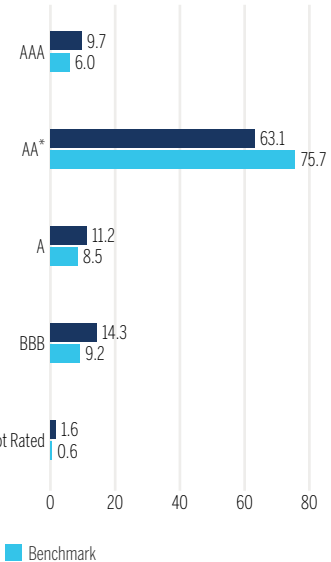
% MARKET VALUE
