

Fund description

Investment objective and overview

The fund invests in an actively managed and broadly diversified portfolio of emerging market bonds. Investments are mainly in debt instruments of sovereign, quasi-sovereign and corporate issuers, which may be denominated in local or hard currency of the issuer. The individual segments and investment types are selected and weighted by exploiting opportunities as they arise, which means that the investment focus can vary depending on the market assessment at the time. The fund is suitable for long-term oriented investors aiming to benefit from an exposure across emerging market bonds and currencies.

Opportunities

The Fund invests broadly across various bond categories, currencies and countries, in accordance with its flexible investment strategy. The Fund invests in a broadly diversified bond universe and seeks various opportunities for returns. The Fund gives investors easy access to emerging markets corporate bonds, which may offer attractive potential returns in various countries and sectors. The objective is to identify the potential investments that, in the Investment manager's opinion, are attractive and could generate positive opportunities for investors. A highly qualified and experienced management team actively manages the Fund.

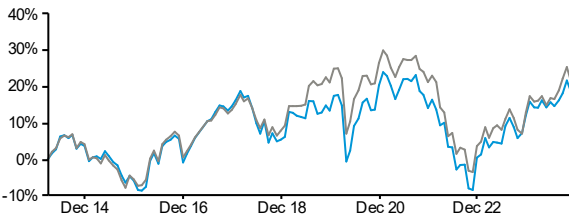

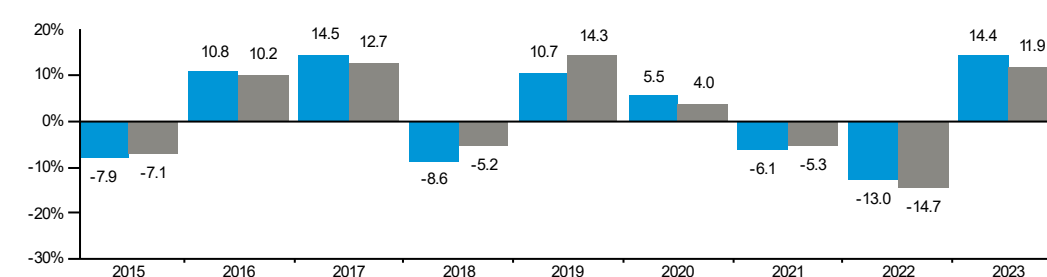

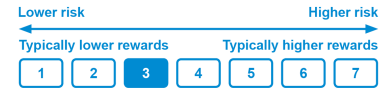

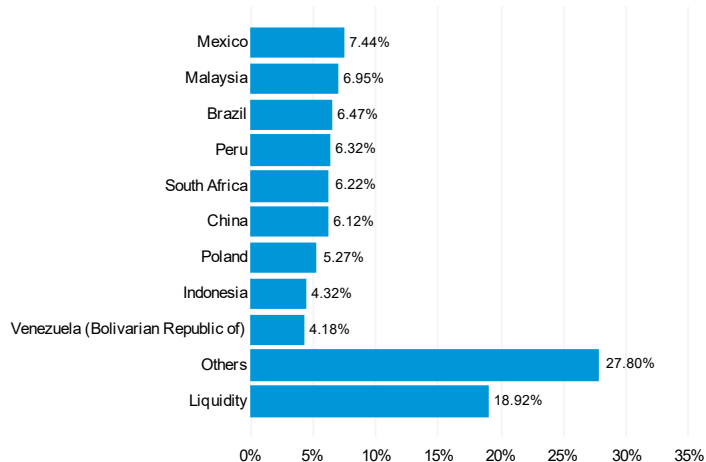

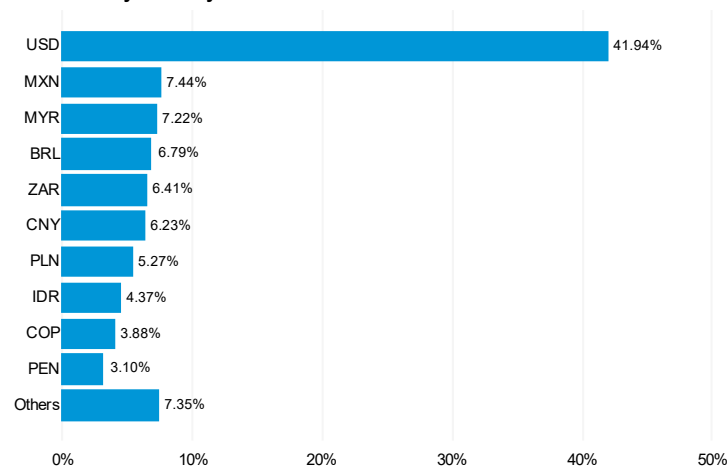

Glossary

Average maturity in years: Average maturity calculates the average maturity period for all the bonds in a portfolio.

Modified duration: a risk indicator that measures the effect of price fluctuations on a bond issue or a portfolio of bond issues.

Ongoing charge: the ongoing charge is a measure of the annual expenses incurred by a fund and is expressed as a percentage. It allows an accurate comparison of the costs of funds from different companies to be made.

Risk rating: The summary risk indicator is a combination of a market risk measure and credit risk measure. The market risk measure is based on an annualized volatility measure, calculated over the last 5 years of history if available. Where 5 years' performance history is not available the data is supplemented by proxy fund, benchmark data or a simulated historical series as appropriate. This profile is determined using historical data, as such may not be a reliable indication for the future risk profile. The credit risk measure is assessing credit and concentration risk within the portfolio. The indicators are not guaranteed and may shift over time. The lowest category does not mean 'risk free'.

Yield to maturity (%): the yield to maturity is the average yield generated by an investment each year if it is held until expiry.
