What is this product?

Type The Company is an open-ended umbrella investment company with variable capital (société d'investissement à capital variable) incorporated under the form of a société anonyme in Luxembourg on 21 March 2000, under the name "BSI-MULTINVEST". It qualifies as an undertaking for collective investment in transferable securities ("UCITS") under Part I of the 2010 Law.

Objectives

Product objectives The Strategic Defensive fund aims to offer consistent risk-adjusted returns during different market conditions by investing in a mix of asset classes and combining our expertise both in terms of asset allocation definition and in terms of portfolio management. Portfolio asset allocation reflects our strategic macro and market views, with various tactical positions also in place. The fund invests across sovereign and corporate bonds, hybrid debt, equities, commodities, hedge funds, money market instruments and other alternatives, using the wealth of in-house expertise and incorporating the best of our proprietary investment approaches from our award winning specialist equity and fixed income fund managers. The Strategy Income fund is designed for clients, with a low to medium risk profile, looking for more diversified asset allocation solutions.

Investment approach The sub-fund objective is to seek the best combination of interest income and capital growth in relation to the reference currency with an emphasis on capital preservation. The sub-fund invests worldwide in the global financial markets on a broadly diversified basis in debt securities and equity instrument. The sub-fund invests at least 50% of its assets, in accordance with the principle of risk spreading, in Debt Securities issued by Sovereigns, Public Local Authorities, Semi-Public Enterprises or Private Borrowers. The sub-fund may not invest more than 30% of its assets in shares or Equity-Like Instruments. The sub-fund may invest up to 10% of its assets in UCITS/UCIs investing mainly in commodity indices. The sub-fund may invest up to 10% of its assets in certificates whose underlying are commodity indices or in securities physically backed by precious metals. The sub-fund invests at least 50% of its assets in securities denominated in EUR. The remaining portion may be invested in securities denominated in other currencies. The sub-fund may not invest more than 15% of its assets in Alternative UCITS and more than 20% of its assets in Liquid Assets. The sub-fund may not invest more than 5% of its assets in A Shares via Stock Connect. The sub-fund may invest up to 100% of its net assets in existing UCITS, UCIs (including ETFs). Derivatives may also be used for investment and hedging. The sub-fund can participate to securities lending activities.

Benchmark The Fund's benchmark is comprised of 32.5% ER01 Index (Euro Corp 1-3 Yr), 32.5% ER02 Index (Euro Corp 3-5 Yr), 10% MSCI AC World Daily TR NET EUR, 5% MSCI EMU Net total Return Eur Index, 5% WisdomTree Broad Commodities EUR Daily Hedge, 10% HFRX global HF, 5% LEC1 Index (Euro Currency LIBOR 1-mo Cons) total return (net) and is used for comparative purposes, and may be used for comparative purposes only. The Fund is actively managed and as such does not seek to replicate its benchmark index, but

instead may differ from the performance benchmark in order to achieve its objective. The sub-investment manager is not constrained by the benchmark in the selection of investments and may use its discretion to invest in companies or sectors not included in the benchmark in order to take advantage of specific investment opportunities.

Redemption policy Shares in the Fund can be bought and sold daily (every Business Day of the Fund). Shares will be redeemed at the nav per share calculated on the relevant valuation day, with applications needing to be received by 12:00 pm (Luxembourg time) on the preceding business day to be processed at that day's NAV. There is no redemption charge.

Distribution policy Any income arising from this Share Class will be accumulated and automatically reinvested.

Exchange policy Subject to the conditions set down in the Prospectus, you are entitled to switch from one share class to another, either in the Fund or in another sub-fund of the Company. Please refer to the Prospectus for further information on how to switch.

Asset segregation The Fund is a sub-fund of the Company, an umbrella fund with segregated liability between sub-funds. You can find out more information about the umbrella fund in the Prospectus.

Derivatives policy Derivatives may be used for investment and hedging.

Intended retail investor The Sub-Fund is suitable as a basic investment for investors that have a medium to long-term investment horizon (between five to ten years) and a low risk tolerance.

Term The Fund is open-ended and has no maturity date. Subject to the liquidation, dissolution and termination rights of the board of the Fund as set forth in the Fund prospectus, the Fund cannot be automatically terminated. Waystone Management Company (Lux) S.A. is not entitled to terminate the product unilaterally. The Company may mandatorily redeem any shares that are owned or held by someone in violation of laws or regulations, or if holding those shares could result in negative tax or financial consequences for the Company, such as requiring registration under various securities or investment laws.

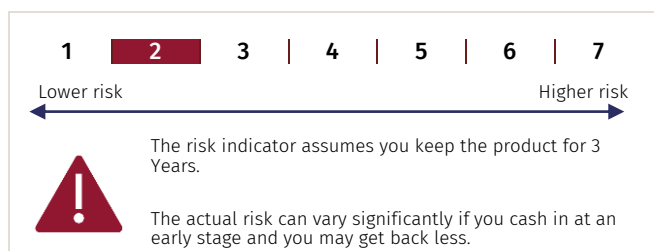

What are the risks and what could I get in return?

Risk Indicator

What happens if Waystone Management Company (Lux) S.A. is unable to pay out?

The Management Company of the Fund has no obligation to pay out since the Fund design does not contemplate any such payment being made. You are not covered by any national compensation scheme. To protect you, the assets are held with a separate company, a depository. Should the Fund default, the depository would liquidate the investments and distribute the proceeds to the investors. In the worst case, however, you could lose your entire investment.

What are the costs?

Costs over time

The tables show the amounts that are taken from your investment to cover different types of costs. These amounts depend on how much you invest, how long you hold the product and how well the product does. - In the first year you would get back the amount that you invested (0 % annual return). For the other holding periods we have assumed the product performs as shown in the moderate scenario.

How long should I hold it and can I take my money out early?

Recommended holding period: 3 Years

This product is designed for longer term investments; you should be prepared to stay invested for at least 3 Years. However, you can redeem your investment without penalty at any time during this period, or hold the investment longer. Redemptions are possible on every working day; it will take 3 working days for you to be paid. The price per share for the day, based on the actual value of the Share Class, is set each day at 23:00 hours.
