## What is this product?

**Type** | Subfund of a SICAV (open-end investment company) governed by French law. Each shareholder has co-ownership rights on the SICAV's net assets in proportion to the number of shares held.

**A.M.F. classification** | International equities

**Term** | The Fund was created on 26/04/2013 and its expected term is 99 years. This term may be extended or the Fund can be dissolved early on the initiative of its Board of Directors. The terms and conditions for extension or dissolution are described in more detail in the articles of association of the SICAV. The Fund has no maturity date.

**Objectives** | Echiquier World Next Leaders is a UCITS with the "International equities" classification managed in a dynamic and discretionary manner through stock-picking on international equity markets and more specifically in companies considered by the management team to be innovative and emerging global leaders (high growth potential) in traditional or burgeoning sectors.

The objective of the UCITS is to deliver over the recommended investment period a performance net of fees greater than that of its benchmark, the MSCI All Country Index Net Return (Euro) net dividends reinvested. However, it is not the subfund's objective to reproduce the performance of this index, and the portfolio's composition may therefore differ substantially from that of the benchmark index.

The UCITS implements an active and discretionary management based on a rigorous stock picking process, involving direct meetings with the companies in which the subfund invests.

The investment strategy seeks to select stocks which, according to the analysis conducted by the management company, offer the best current or potential growth, and have the criteria to be tomorrow's leaders in their area, in all regions of the world and all sectors. At all times, a minimum of 75% of the net assets of Echiquier World Next Leaders will be invested in listed equities, with a maximum of 50% in emerging-market equities. These will mainly be stocks whose market capitalisation is below 20 bn euros. The subfund will however also be able to invest in small-cap stocks with a market capitalisation of less than 500 mn euros up to a limit of 10% of its net assets.

Compliance with the market capitalisation criterion is assessed at the time of the initial investment in the equities in question.

The exposure to the equity risk will be at least 60%, of which a maximum of 50% to emerging markets.

The UCITS reserves the right to invest a maximum of 25% in fixed-income products. At the time of acquisition and for monitoring purposes over the life of

the securities, credit risk is assessed on the basis of in-house research and analysis by La Financière de l'Échiquier and using the ratings produced by agencies. Eligible securities are deemed investment grade, i.e., having a minimum Standard & Poor's rating of BBB- or equivalent or considered as such by the management team.

Derivative instruments, whether or not traded on regulated markets or over the counter, can be used on a discretionary basis to:

- Hedge the portfolio against currency risk and against equity risk when the manager anticipates a significant deterioration in market performance;
- Occasionally expose the portfolio to equity risk during significant subscription transactions. The subfund does not, in any event, intend to implement a strategy of over-exposing the portfolio to equity risk.

Furthermore, the portfolio management team systematically includes an extra-financial approach in building the portfolio, although extra-financial criteria are not a determining factor in investment decisions.

**Allocation of income** | Accumulation

**Cut-off time for centralising subscription/redemption orders** | The investor may obtain a redemption on request every business day. Redemption requests are centralised each market trading day before 12 p.m. (Paris time) with our centralising agent BNP Paribas SA and executed on the net asset value calculated on the closing price on the day they are centralised.

**Valuation frequency** | The net asset value is calculated daily except on days when the Paris stock exchange is closed and on French public holidays.

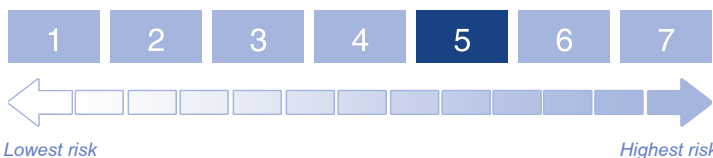

## What are the risks and what could I get in return?

### Risk indicator



The risk indicator is based on the assumption that you hold the shares for 5 years.



The real risk can be very different if you opt for an exit before this period, and you could get less in return.

The synthetic risk indicator makes it possible to assess the level of risk of this product compared to others. It indicates the likelihood that this product will incur losses in the event of market movements or if we are unable to pay you.

We have classified the product in risk class 5 out of 7, which is a medium to high risk class. In other words, the potential losses linked to the product's future results are medium to high, and if the situation deteriorates in the financial markets, it is likely that our ability to pay you will be affected.

## What happens if La Financière de l'Échiquier is unable to pay out?

The product is a co-ownership of financial instruments and deposits separate from the management company. In the event of failure of the latter, the assets of the product held in custody by the depositary will not be affected. In the case of failure of the depositary, the risk of financial loss for the product is reduced due to the legal segregation of the assets of the depositary and those of the product.

## What are the costs?

### Costs over time:

The tables show the amounts deducted from your investment in order to cover the different types of costs. We assumed:

- that in the first year you will recover the amount you invested (annual return of 0%). That for other holding periods, the product changes as indicated in the moderate scenario.
