What is this product?

TYPE OF PRODUCT

The product is a sub-fund of ONE Sustainable Fund, an Undertaking for Collective Investment in Transferable Securities (UCITS) incorporated as a Fonds Commun de Placement (FCP) under the laws of Luxembourg.

The Sub-Fund is established for an unlimited duration. However, the Management Company may decide to close this product under certain circumstances.

Objectives and investment policy

The objective of the Sub-Fund is to achieve long-term capital growth while giving due consideration to capital security, environmental and social criteria.

The Sub-Fund will have an exposure to any type of equity and equity related security issued by companies operating in technologies associated with environmental themes and considered to present investment opportunities that are likely to yield superior investment returns in the medium to long term. The Sub- Fund invests in various themes whereby each theme is linked to one or more important environmental and economic challenges, examples being climate change, use of natural resources, preservation of biodiversity and demographic trends.

The Sub-Fund's investment focus includes corporations that are engaged in the following industry groups: renewable energy, energy efficiency, ecological materials, environmental chemistry and biology, environmental advisory, sustainable mobility, waste management, water management.

The Sub-Fund will mainly invest:

- directly in the securities mentioned in the previous paragraph; and/or
- in undertakings for collective investment (UCIs) having as main objective to invest or grant an exposure to the above-mentioned securities; and/or
- in any transferable securities (such as structured products) linked or offering an exposure to the performance of the above-mentioned securities.

The choice of investments will neither be limited by geographical area (including emerging markets), nor in terms of currencies in which investments will be denominated. However, depending on financial market conditions, a particular focus can be placed in a single country (or some countries) and/or in a single currency.

The remaining assets can be invested in any other type of eligible assets, such as equities other than those above mentioned, any type of debt securities, money market instruments, cash.

If the investment manager considers this to be in the best interest of the shareholders, the Sub-Fund may also, hold, up to 100% of its net assets, liquidities as among others cash deposits, money market UCIs and money market instruments.

Derivatives For hedging and for investment purposes, the Sub-Fund may use all types of financial derivative instruments traded on a regulated market and/or over the counter.

Benchmark The Sub-Fund is actively managed. The benchmark index of the Sub-Fund is MSCI World Net Total Return EUR Index. It is mentioned only for performance comparison purposes and the Sub-Fund does not track the index. The Sub-Fund can deviate significantly or entirely from the benchmark index.

ESG information The Sub-Fund is managed to promote, among other characteristics, a combination of environmental and social characteristics within the meaning of article 8 of SFDR, but does not have a Sustainable Investment (as defined in the prospectus) objective.

The companies in which the Sub-Fund invests will follow good governance practices. The Investment Manager monitors the good governance practices of the investee companies via the governance ratings.

The Investment Manager integrates Sustainability Risks and opportunities into its research, analysis and investment decision-making processes.

The characteristics promoted by the Sub-Fund consist of investing in companies having a positive impact on the environment that is derived directly from their operational activity.

Dividend Policy This Class is cumulative. Dividend distributions are not planned.

Share Class Currency The currency of the Class is EUR.

The recommended holding period of this product is determined to allow sufficient time for this product to reach its objectives and avoiding short term market

The return of the product is determined using the Net Asset Value (the "NAV") calculated by FundPartner Solutions (Europe) S.A. (the "Administrative Agent"). This return depends mainly on the market value fluctuations of the underlying investments.

INTENDED RETAIL INVESTORS

The product is suitable for retail investors with limited knowledge of the underlying financial instruments and no financial industry experience. The product is compatible with investors who may bear capital losses and who do not need capital guarantee. The product is compatible with clients looking for growing their capital and who wish to hold their investment over 6 years.

Asset segregation The assets and liabilities of each sub-fund are segregated by law, which means that the performance of the assets in other sub-funds does not influence the performance of your investment.

Dealing The NAV for the Unitclass is calculated on each bank business day in Luxembourg ("the Calculation Day") based on the prices of the preceding bank business day ("the Valuation Day"). The cut-off time to submit subscriptions and/or redemptions orders is 4 p.m. Luxembourg time on the bank business day preceding the Calculation Day.

Switching Unitholders can switch between Sub-Funds and unitclasses if the conditions for admission to the target unitclass, fund type or fund sub-type have been fulfilled and the respective NAV on the Valuation Day is calculated after receipt of the application for switching. The subscription and redemption fees associated with the switch can be charged to the unitholders according to the prospectus. What are the risks and what could I get in return?

Be aware of currency risk. You will receive payments in a different currency, so the final return you will get depends on the exchange rate between the two currencies. This risk is not considered in the indicator shown above.

What happens if FundPartner Solutions (Europe) S.A. is unable to pay out?

The Management Company is not making any payment to you in relation to the Sub-Fund and you would still be paid in case of a default from the Management Company.

The Sub-Fund's assets are held with a separate company, the Depositary, so the Sub-Fund's ability to pay out would not be affected by the insolvency of the Management Company. However, in the event of the Depositary's insolvency, or its delegates, the Sub-Fund may suffer a financial loss. However, this risk is mitigated to a certain extent by the fact the Depositary is required by law and regulation to segregate its own assets from the assets of the Sub-Fund. The Depositary will also be liable to the Sub-Fund or its investors for any loss arising from, among other things, its negligence, fraud or intentional failure properly to fulfill its obligations (subject to certain limitations).

If the Sub-Fund is terminated or wound up, the assets will be liquidated and you will receive an appropriate share of any proceeds but you may lose part or all of your investment.

There is no compensation or guarantee scheme protecting you from a default of the Depositary.

What are the costs?

The person advising on or selling you this product may charge you other costs. If so, this person will provide you with information about these costs and how they affect your investment.

Costs over time

The tables show the amounts that are taken from your investment to cover different types of costs. These amounts depend on how much you invest, how long you hold the product and how well the product does. The amounts shown here are illustrations based on an example investment amount and different possible investment periods.

We have assumed:

- In the first year you would get back the amount that you invested (0% annual return). For the other holding periods we have assumed the product performs as shown in the moderate scenario.
