What is the product?

Type: This Product is an investment company qualifying as UCITS Sub-fund in accordance with the UCITS law.

Term: This Product has no maturity date. The Sub-fund has been established for an indefinite period of time. The Board of Directors of the Investment Company is entitled to liquidate, merge or reposition the Product at any time unilaterally in case the Product can no longer be managed in the interest of the investors. The amount the investor will receive upon early termination may be less than the amount invested.

Objectives: This Bond Sub-fund is actively managed without reference to a benchmark aiming to achieve capital appreciation in the short- to medium term. The Investment Manager uses EURIBOR to reference the return objective. The Sub-fund promotes environmental, social and governance (ESG) characteristics (within the meaning of Article 8 of Regulation (EU) 2019/2088) through a combination of different portfolio management techniques. Details are available in the prospectus and the ESG website disclosure of the Sub-fund. The Sub-fund invests in a diversified portfolio of fixed income securities, such as but not limited to bonds, convertible bonds, certificates and hybrid bonds. Up to 50% of the Sub-fund's net assets may be invested in CoCos (Contigent convertible instruments). The Sub-fund may invest in units of other UCITS (up to 20% of net assets). It invests without being limited to a specific currency, geographic scope or industrial sector. Securities of issuers with a rating below "B—" by Standard & Poor's or "B3" by Moody's cannot be held. In order to achieve its objective, the Sub-fund can use derivative instruments to protect against movements in currencies and security prices, for investment purposes and for efficient portfolio management. In case of investments in Total Return Swaps, the maximum value of the investments might reach up to 20% of the Sub-fund's net assets. The investor can buy or sell shares on a daily basis (Luxembourg and Switzerland bank business days). This Share Class makes regular distributions. The Sub-fund shall bear the costs of standard brokerage and bank charges incurred by the Sub-fund through securities transactions in relation to the portfolio.

Intended Retail Investor: This Product is intended for professional and institutional investors, with an ability to bear a minor investment loss, and a long-term investment horizon.

What are the risks and what could I get in return?

(A) Summary Risk Indicator





The risk indicator assumes you keep the Product for 5 years. The actual risk can vary significantly if you redeem at an early stage and you may get back less.

The Summary Risk Indicator is a guide to the level of risk of this Product compared to other products. It shows how likely it is that the Product will lose money because of movements in the markets.
