What is this product?

Type: Société d'investissement à capital variable (Lux)

Objectives

Product objectives: The fund aims to achieve capital growth in the long term by investing in healthcare securities taking account of sustainability criteria.

Investment approach: The Fund invests in healthcare equities worldwide taking account of sustainability criteria.

Investment policy: The Fund invests at least two thirds of the net assets of the fund in a portfolio of carefully chosen shares and other equity securities of companies in the healthcare sector taking account of sustainability criteria. The fund can also invest in companies whose main activity involves holding investments in such companies or financing such companies and that have their registered office or carry out the majority of their economic activity in recognised countries. Without limiting the scope of "healthcare sector", the healthcare sector includes companies from the areas of pharmaceuticals, medical technology, biotechnology and related sectors. Up to one third of the net assets can be invested in debt securities of private and government issuers with various terms and credit ratings. The Fund may engage in derivative transactions in order to achieve an efficient portfolio management, in particular also for hedging purposes.

Benchmark: The benchmark, MSCI World Healthcare Net reference index, is used for comparison purposes and for analyzing value. The benchmark is not used for portfolio construction and has some discretion to deviate from its composition and risk characteristics.

The Fund is actively managed and does not track the index; thus, the Investment Manager's discretion may result in performance that differs from the benchmark.

Redemption policy: Shares of the Fund may be redeemed on demand, with dealing normally on a daily basis.

Distribution policy: The fund does not pay dividends. Earned income is retained in the NAV.

Exchange policy: You can exchange your shares in the fund for shares in another fund of Bellevue Funds (Lux) SICAV, provided that the conditions for purchasing the respective share class are fulfilled.

Asset segregation: The assets of each fund of the fund are segregated. This means that each fund is liable only for its own losses and liabilities, and does not cover any loss or liability associated with other funds.

Sustainability policy: Exclusion criteria and best-in-class ESG/CSR criteria are established in line with the following guidelines: The Austrian Ecolabel Guideline, Guidelines for Ethically Sustainable Investment in the Evangelical Church, Catholic Church Guidance on Sustainable and the Principles of the United Nations Global Compact. Companies that commit grave breaches of the principles and standards regarding compliance, human rights and labor enshrined in the UN Global Compact are excluded. Furthermore, no investments are made in companies linked to controversial weapons.

SFDR: Article 8

Derivatives policy: The fund can carry out derivative transactions for the purposes of hedging, efficient portfolio management and the generation of additional income.

Intended retail investor: This product is intended for investors who plan to stay invested for at least 5 years and are prepared to take on a medium-high level of risk of loss to their original capital in order to get a higher potential return. It is designed to form part of a portfolio of investments.

Term: The PRIIP has no maturity date.

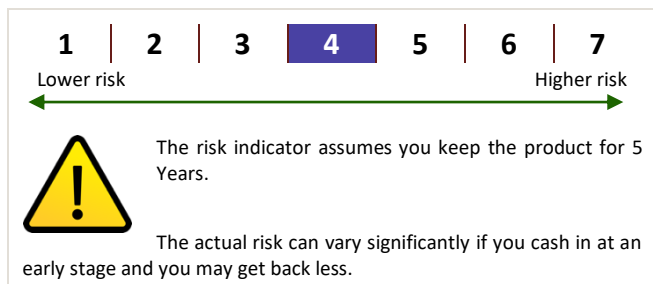

What are the risks and what could I get in return?

Risk Indicator



The summary risk indicator is a guide to the level of risk of this product compared to other products. It shows how likely it is that the product will lose money because of movements in the markets or because we are not able to pay you.

We have classified this product as 4 out of 7, which is a medium risk class. This raises the potential losses from future performance at a medium level, and poor market conditions could impact the capacity to pay you.

Be aware of currency risk. You will receive payments in a different currency, so the final return you will get depends on the exchange rate between the two currencies. This risk is not considered in the indicator shown above.

Credit risks: The fund can invest some of its assets in bonds. It is possible that the issuers of these bonds may become insolvent.

Liquidity risk: The fund may invest some of its assets in financial instruments that may in certain circumstances reach a relatively low level of liquidity, which can have an impact on the fund's liquidity.

Risks arising from the use of derivatives: The fund may conclude derivatives transactions. This increases opportunities, but also involves an increased risk of loss.

Operational risks and custody risks: The fund is subject to risks due to operational or human errors, which can arise at the investment company, the custodian bank, a custodian or other third parties.

Counterparty risks: If a contractual partner becomes insolvent, it can no longer or can only partly settle unpaid debts owed to the fund.

If we are not able to pay you what is owed, you could lose your entire investment.

Performance Scenarios

What happens if Waystone Management Company (Lux) S.A. is unable to pay out?

Waystone is a Société Anonyme and has been appointed as the Management Company of the Fund. The Fund is a Société d'Investissement à Capital Variable and its assets are segregated from those of the Management Company. The Fund has entrusted the Custodian with the safekeeping of its assets, which are held separately from the assets of the Custodian. Therefore, a default by Waystone will not affect the value of your investment in the product. You are not covered by a national compensation system.

What are the costs?

The person advising on or selling you this product may charge you other costs. If so, this person will provide you with information about these costs and how they affect your investment.

Costs over time

The tables show the amounts that are taken from your investment to cover different types of costs. These amounts depend on how much you invest, how long you hold the product and how well the product does. The amounts shown here are illustrations based on an example investment amount and different possible investment periods.

We have assumed:

- In the first year you would get back the amount that you invested (0 % annual return). For the other holding periods we have assumed the product performs as shown in the moderate scenario.
- CHF 10 000 is invested.

How long should I hold it and can I take my money out early?

Recommended holding period: 5 Years

This product is designed for longer term investments; you should be prepared to stay invested for at least 5 years. However, you can redeem your investment without penalty at any time during this period, or hold the investment longer. Redemptions are possible on every working day; it will take 3 working days for you to be paid.
